June Whetstone, 93, passed away on Thursday, July 25, 2013 at her Rancho Bernardo home. June was born on November 19, 1919 in New Brunswick, NJ to Andrew and Edna Sicknick. She was an Honors graduate of Douglass College, Rutgers University. After college June was a technical librarian for the DuPont and Shell Development companies before becoming a full time homemaker.
