Interment of ashes will be at Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery beside her husband Sal.




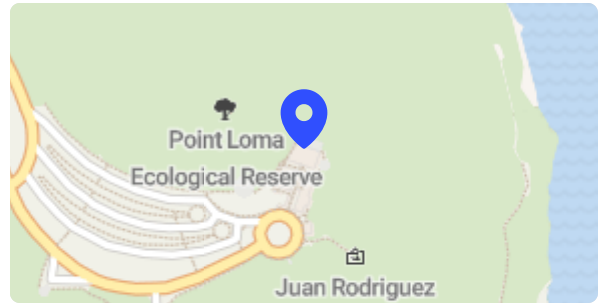
