You made me laugh, cry and be so happy.” True to his caring nature, he went on to encourage her, “Now don’t cry, be happy as you made me since I met you!” Gary is also survived by a son, James and James’ wife Janie, of Jerome, Idaho; as well as by his mother, Mildred Barnard, his brother Gregory Williamson, his sister Roberta Williamson Cultrera and brother-in-law Mike Cultrera, his nephew Michael Cultrera, Michael’s wife Rashelle, their two children, Bella and Kaleena, as well as his niece Michele Cultrera Wong and her husband Brian Wong.

Gary will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.

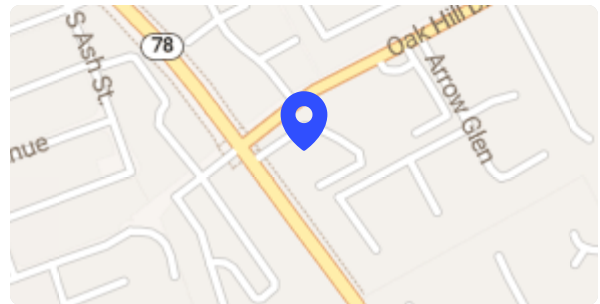

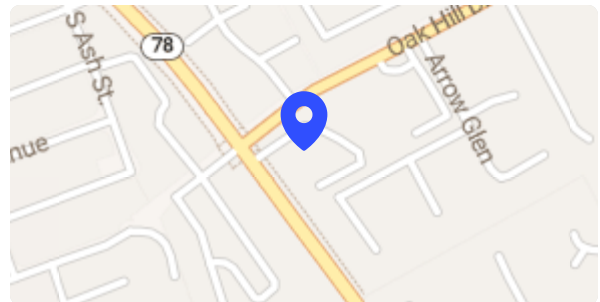

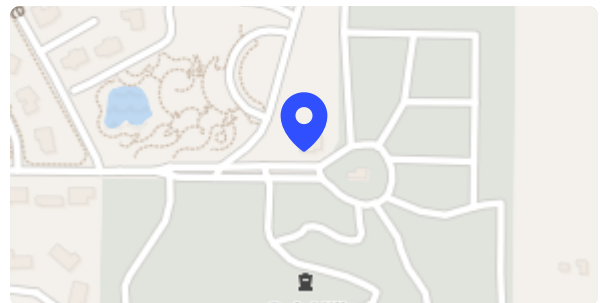
