May She Rest in Peace.

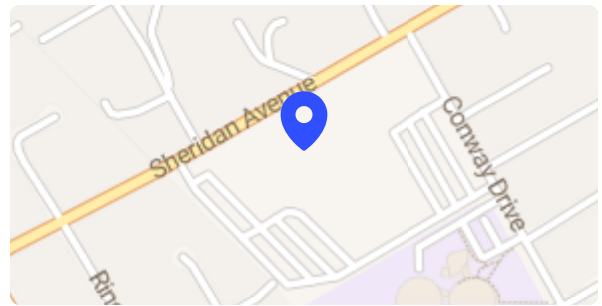

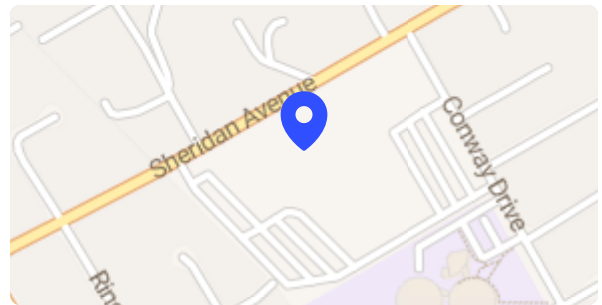
