She was a loving daughter, sister, mother, and grandmother, and will be forever immensely missed by many.



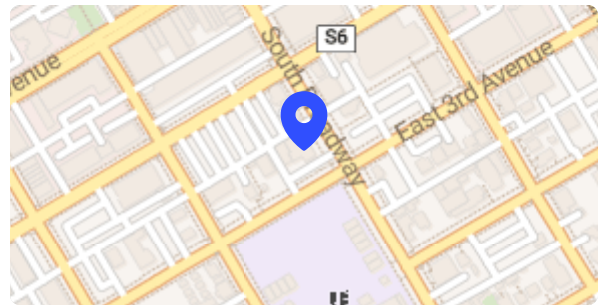
