John Christopher Wickliffe, died Monday, April 20, 2026 in San Marcos, CA., John was 66 years young. He was born in Escondido, in October, 1959 and was the fourth son of Robert Wickliffe and Elizabeth Wickliffe. Growing up in Escondido during the 60's and 70's he and his older brother Jeff, who both had inquisitive and adventuresome spirits, spent many days exploring the natural and undeveloped areas of Escondido on their bicycles.

John graduated from Orange Glen High in 1978. He went on to work with his hometown newspaper the Times Advocate, as well as time at the Parks Department for the City of San Diego at Lake Hodges, and positions in the auto mechanic and landscaping fields. 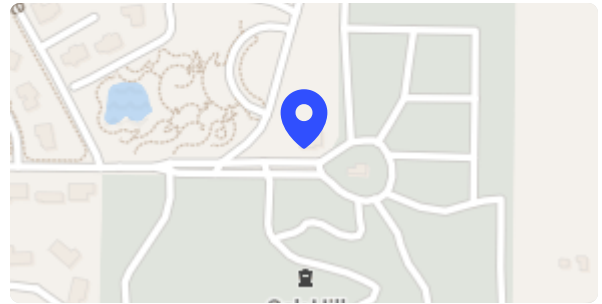
